Hello FFG MADNESS IN MARCH 2022 Player!

We're so excited to have you on board for the tournament! A few things before the event starts:

THE NBA 2K22 TOURNAMENT WILL BEGIN AT 1:00 PM EST on Saturday March 26, 2022.

Step 1 - To compete in the online event you must be a member of the FFG Discord at in order to participate. Join at <https://discord.gg/bdxqFw2>.

Step 2 - Be sure to tag @FFG Staff in the general channel with the following "NBA 2K22 Madness in March 2022" so you will be assigned to the appropriate channel. Ex "@FFG Staff, NBA 2K22 Madness in March 2022"

NOTE - You must be in the Discord server by 12:30pm on March 26, 2022. This will serve as your official check in. All online tournament event communications will take place in Discord.

Here are the rules for the tournament. Please familiarize yourself!

Tournament Format & Rules:

1. Anti-Cheat

No additional anti-cheat is required for official matches.

2. Match Procedure

Platforms - XBOX ONE or PS4

2.1. Series Lengths

Matches are played as a best of 1 in the playoffs and grand finals.

2.2. Game Lobby

Prior to the match, players should add each other as friends on their Consoles. The designated home team will create the lobby. Away team will have first choice of team.

The following settings are to be used in official matches:

Connection: Play With Friends

Quarter Length: 5 Minutes

Game Mode: Private Match

Game Style: Simulation

Fatigue: On

Injuries: Off

Difficulty: Hall of Fame

3. Restrictions

3.1. Pausing the game

Player may not at any point use the pause feature during game play. Each team is afforded a certain number of times outs during the match.

3.2 All-Time Teams/All-Star Teams/History Teams/Custom Teams

Only current teams may be used in official matches. The use of custom teams, all-star teams, all-time teams, and history teams are prohibited.

4. Stoppage of Play

4.1 Disconnection

A match can be reset if a player disconnects from a match as long as the following criteria are met:

The disconnection happens in the first 3 minutes of the First Quarter

The score difference is 15 or less

The player has not disconnected previously during the match

Any other Disconnections or multiple disconnections will count as a loss for the disconnected player.

5. Player Count

Matches are played as 1 versus 1, meaning that only one player may participate in the match for either side. No player substitutions may be made at any point during the match.

6. Reporting Score

Players will be responsible for taking screenshots of the score and reporting them to tournament admins online in the NBA 2K22 "mim22_results" Channel. **Winning player should post the screenshot of the final score and tag their opponent (@xxx) for confirmation.** Improperly reported scores will not be counted.
